



## AWARDS RULES AND REGULATIONS

## Applied Activity A

The PhD short school trainees willing to participate in Applied Activity A will be distributed in working groups, based on their area of expertise. Each working group will be assigned with an EU open call linked to the topics of the PhD short school and will be requested to produce a 3-pages proposal abstract. The open calls will be assigned on Monday October 11<sup>th</sup> in the afternoon and every day after the lectures as well as on Thursday October 14 in the afternoon the working groups will meet in virtual rooms and co-work on their proposal. On Thursday October 14<sup>th</sup> in the evening the proposal abstracts will be submitted to the Evaluation Committee A, that will shortlist five proposals to be presented (10 min) and discussed on Friday October 15<sup>th</sup> in the afternoon. The working group that will be ranked 1<sup>st</sup> will be awarded a 3000 euros prize. The working group that will be ranked a 2000 euros prize.

## Applied Activity B

The PhD short school trainees willing to participate in Applied Activity B will have to submit a 2pages summary of their own PhD research activities. The Evaluation Committee B will shortlist sixteen participants who will be requested to present (10 min) and discuss their PhD activities on Friday (October 15<sup>th</sup>) morning. Each candidate ranked 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> will be awarded a 600 euros prize.
